

# CCP6 To XCS Importer Installation README

This document outlines installation instructions for the CCP6 to XCS Importer for application data.

## SOFTWARE REQUIREMENTS

The following requirements need to be met before running this import script.

1. The XCS ClickCartPro software installed.
2. The CCP6 website you wish to import the data from.

## INSTALLATION SETUP

You downloaded an importer installation archive file from GreenbarnWeb. The installation archive file will be named: importer-ccp6-uk.zip

When you extract this file locally using a utility like WinZip (Windows) or unzip (Linux), it will contain the following files:

importer-ccp6-uk.php

readme.pdf

skinchanges.html

FolderComparisonReport\_files

## UPLOADING FILES TO YOUR WEBSERVER

You will need to upload the importer PHP file you extracted from the installation archive file. Upload this file to the Public Directory your XCS installation uses. Example:

/home/account/www/xcs/importer-ccp6-uk.php

## SETTING PERMISSIONS

After you've uploaded the importer PHP file from the installation archive file to the Public Directory on your webserver, you will need to ensure permissions are set correctly on that file.

For Unix/Linux web servers: Setting permissions on the importer PHP file in the Public Directory is done using your FTP client software. Simply highlight the file and choose to change it's 'Permissions', 'Properties' or 'CHMOD'. If your webserver requires PHP scripts to run with execute permissions, you will have to set a permission level of '755'. Otherwise you may not have to adjust permission on the importer PHP file.

For Windows web servers: You will not need to adjust permissions on the importer PHP file.

## RUNNING THE IMPORTER

After you've set permissions on the importer PHP file, access the importer script to continue through the import process. To access the importer script, simply open your web browser and browse to the location of the importer PHP script you uploaded earlier. Example:

To run the importer you will need the following information:

1. The XCS installer password.
2. The private and public directories of the CCP6 install, that information can be found in the config.php in the public directory of the CCP6 install.

The importer will allow you to transfer the following information from the CCP6 to XCS.

- Affiliate Payment Info
- Customer Cart Contents
- Product Categories
- Checkout Extra Fields
- Customer Account Info
- Custom Menu Info
- Discount Codes
- Dynamic Form Info
- Front End Menu Info
- Payment Gateway Info
- HTML Page Info
- Guest Email Subscriptions
- Copy Product, Category and HTML images
- Order Info
- Product, options and option selection info
- Customer Session Info
- Settings Info
- Store Menu Info
- Shipping Info
- Copy over your CCP6 skins and set your current default skin

Please Note: To take advantage of the new functionality in XCS you will have to make some manual changes to the default skin. To see an example of the changes you will need to make open the skinchanges.html in a web browser, this gives you the full information on the changes you need to make.

## **REMOVING THE IMPORTER**

Remove the importer PHP script from your webserver account after completing your data import.
